Please see reception for porter service at least 1 hour before departure. Kindly leave your bags locked and placed outside of your room.

Free gated parking is available at the mainland jetty. No 24-hour security is provided therefore please remove valuables and lock your vehicle before departing the jetty. The resort accepts no liability for loss or damage.

Board meals are served buffet-style in open-air seating on the white sandy beach. The Lali (Fijian drum) signals mealtimes:

Lunch: 1–2pm

Dinner: 7–8pm

Fully licensed ocean view bar sells bottled water, soft drinks, beers, cocktails, wine, selected spirits & snacks. Ring the bell (left of counter) if unattended.

*Guided Village Tour and Mud Crab Catching

To join the village visit and mud crab catching with the tour group please liaise with reception as you will have to depart the island at 9am. For the Village Tour guests are required to contribute \$30 per adult and \$15 per child. No additional charge for the mud crab catching component.

When visiting the local villages, it is compulsory for women to wear clothes that cover shoulders and knees. Hats and sunglasses should not be worn inside the village area.

Sunset Cruise, Dinner & Show Tours

Operates Monday, Wednesday and Saturday (6-9pm).

Other Information

Holiday Hints

Please ensure you apply sunscreen to protect yourself against the tropical sun and drink plenty of water. If you are undertaking unsupervised watersports, please advise reception or watersports staff of your plans. Please report any incidents to the Resort Manager or Duty Manager.

Insects / Animals / Marine-Life

Being situated on a tropical island, it is not uncommon to see occasional mosquitoes and other insects, frogs, spiders, geckos, land crabs and other such creatures. Please do not be alarmed, none are poisonous. We suggest that you close your room doors at sunset to keep insects out. Any food left in the room may attract ants. We also recommend applying a tropical strength insect repellent (available for purchase at the bar) at dusk/early evening to prevent mosquito and sand-fly bites. The ocean is also full of marine life, some of which can be dangerous.

IMPORTANT: When entering the sea (especially at low tide), it is advisable to shuffle your feet to avoid stepping on marine animals hidden in the sand such as rays as they may sting if startled.

Power

Electricity current is 240 volts AC-50 Cycles. Outlets are the same as Australia/New Zealand. Our power is provided by a generator and there may be intermittent periods without power when we are switching over. We kindly request you switch off the Air Conditioner when you are out of the room to conserve energy and fuel.

Tipping and Staff Interaction

Tipping is not customary in Fiji; however, if you feel you have received great service, a Staff Donation box is located at reception, with all proceeds being split evenly by all staff. We would like to remind our valued guests that our resort maintains a strict policy against offering alcohol and cigarettes to our staff members.

Staff members are not permitted in the guest accommodation areas of the resort unless their duties require. This policy is in place to uphold the professional environment and well-being of our team. We kindly ask for your cooperation in refraining from providing these items. Thank you for your understanding.

Water

Complimentary bottles of water are provided daily in the rooms. We desalinate our own water supply and it is suitable for bathing and teeth brushing but not drinking. Additional bottled drinking water is available for purchase at the bar. Please be mindful of water usage when showering & remember to turn the taps off.

Wifi / Internet

Free Wifi is available at public areas and Beachfront Bures. High Speed internet is available for purchase.
