### Note

Outer reef snorkeling is at an additional cost of \$15 per person. For the village tour, guests are required to make a contribution of \$30 per adult and \$15 per child.

### Village dress code

When entering a local village, it is compulsory for women to wear clothes that cover shoulders and knees and no wearing of hats while inside the village arena for all guests.

# Arrival/Departure

## Bags / Luggage

Please contact reception for porter service at least 1 hour before departure. Kindly leave your bags locked and placed outside of your room. Please return your key upon check-out to avoid a penalty of \$50.

## Boat Transfer Schedule

Boat transfers are available daily. Please enquire at reception.

Depart Likuri Island to Mainland Jetty  
9.00am, 1.30pm, 4.00pm  
Depart Mainland Jetty to Likuri Island  
10.00am, 2.00pm, 5.00pm  
10.00pm (Mon, Wed, Sat only)

For transfers outside of these hours, please see reception.

## Check in time / Check out time

Check in time is 12.00pm.

Check out time is 8.00am.

Late check out and day rooms are subject to availability and will incur a fee.

## Guest Accounts

Resort guests can charge all purchases at Likuri Island Resort to their room account. Please settle your accounts with reception at least 1 hour before your departure.

## Beach/Pool Towels

Available at reception. Kindly return after use.

## Carpark

Gated car parking is provided at the mainland Jetty for free. Kindly note that we do not provide security service 24 hours, therefore please ensure to remove any valuable items and lock your car doors before departing the Jetty. The resort will not be held liable for any losses or damages.

## Dining

For all guests staying on the island there is a compulsory Meal Plan that includes Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. All meals are served in an open air seating on a white sandy beach area.

The Lali (Fijian Drum) will beat when it's time to eat!

Meal times below:

Breakfast is served from	8.00am to 9.00am
Lunch is served from	1.00pm to 2.00pm
Dinner is served from	7.00pm to 8.00pm

Meals are served buffet style but on days with low number of guests, buffet meals will be replaced with plated meals. The resort caters for vegetarians, and most food allergies can be accommodated if adequate notice is provided, please see reception.

## Drinks / Bar

Our resort bar is a fully licensed bar with ocean views and sells bottled water, soft drinks, beers, cocktails, red & white wine, selected spirits and snacks. Open from 8am until late.

## Hairdryer & Iron

Available at reception. Kindly return after use.

## Kasi Kasi Kids Club

Kids club available for ages 5-12 years old. Please see reception to register your child.

Opens daily from 8am - 1pm and 2pm - 5pm.

## Likuri Spa

Relax and get a Fijian massage at our spa. Services include 30 minutes or 1 hour Full Body massage or Head, Neck and Shoulders massage. Please book at reception.

## Souvenirs

Should you wish to take a piece of Likuri home, souvenirs are available for purchase at the bar including Likuri t-shirts, Likuri hats, and more.

## Swimming Pool

The resort pool is located near reception and opens daily from 8am to 7pm. Please abide by the pool rules for your own safety.

# Other Information

## Holiday Hints

Please ensure you apply sunscreen to protect yourself against the tropical sun. If you are undertaking unsupervised watersports, please see one of the island staff and advise them of your plans. Please report any incidents to the Resort Manager or Duty Manager.

## Insects / Animals

Being situated on a tropical island, it is not uncommon to see occasional mosquitoes, bugs,

spiders, lizards and land crabs. Please do not be alarmed, none are poisonous & they will not harm you. We suggest that you close your room doors at sunset to keep insects out. Additionally, it's worth noting that food left in the room may attract ants. We also recommend applying a tropical strength insect repellent (available for purchase at the bar) at dusk/early evening to prevent mosquito and sand-fly bites.

## Power

Electricity current is 240 volts AC-50 Cycles. Outlets are the same as Australian/New Zealand. Our power is driven by generators and there may be a minute without power when we are switching over. We kindly request you switch off the Air Conditioner when you are out of the room.

## Tipping

Tipping is not customary in Fiji, however if you feel you have received great service, the Staff have a Staff Donation box located in reception.

We would like to remind our valued guests that our resort maintains a strict policy against offering alcohol and cigarettes to our staff members. This policy is in place to uphold the professional environment and well-being of our team. We kindly ask for your cooperation in refraining from providing these items. Thank you for your understanding.

## Water

Complimentary bottle of water is provided daily in the rooms. We desalinate our own water supply and it is suitable for bathing and teeth brushing but not drinking. Alternatively bottled drinking water is also available for purchase at the bar.

## Wifi / internet

Wifi vouchers can be purchased at reception and only available in public areas.
